TREASURER'S REPORT

OLD BUSINESS

- **SECOND READING, ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2022**, Property Tax rate of 0.29 cents per \$100 valuation for the July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Brian Sutton made a Motion to accept the Budget, seconded by Jeff Toler. **MOTION CARRIED**
- **SECOND READING, ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES 2022**, establishing the Budget for July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Brian Sutton made a Motion to accept the Budget, seconded by Jeff Toler. **MOTION CARRIED.**
- Stan has requested the Briarwood Sales Tax Exempt certificate from the KY Dept of Treasury.

NEW BUSINESS


- Rumpke's 2022-2023 contract price has increased to \$61,566 a year due to fuel surcharges. Due to this change in terms, a public bid request for trash service is needed. Mike McGrath will ask Rumpke for monthly service until the bid process is complete.
- Mike has recently spoken with the corporate Rumpke VP of operations because of the lack of service received per our contract, specifically missing pickup on Greenbriar Ct.

The VP will be reaching out to our local Rumpke service manager the day before, as well as the day after, Friday collection each week until this is resolved.

- Mike has spoken with Paul Maddox CPA regarding the 2019 and 2021 audit work. The price per audit is \$4000.
- Pat O'Donnel Landscaping will begin charging a temporary fuel surcharge.
- The park and women's restroom were vandalized. There was more discussion regarding installing cameras and motion detection lighting.
- Mike McGrath was able to add an insurance rider thru KLC to cover the July 4th water slide.

Next meeting will be Tuesday July 5, 2022, at the Meadowvale City Hall because the July 4th holiday falls on the regular Monday meeting date.
