
OLD BUSINESS



- The dog park is currently on hold. Jason says heavier equipment is needed, but it is currently not possible to access the park with heavier equipment.

NEW BUSINESS

- Rumpke presented a two year contract for services totaling \$71,550 per year (\$5,962.50/month). Although a bid request was published, Rumpke was the only company to complete the bid process. A **MOTION** was made by Mike McGrath to accept the bid. Rob Toler **SECONDED** the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.**
- Discussion continues about installing motion lights and security cameras at the park. Mike McGrath will contact Spectrum to install internet service in the shed.
